IMPORTANT NOTES

Registrations: To avoid the problem of having the extremely time consuming task of team selection being done twice due to the late receipt of registration forms, any player whose registration is received after **19th February 2010** will be slotted into the next available team. This may mean at a lower level than would normally be the case. If financial constraints make it difficult for you to pay your child's registration by 19th February, please speak (in confidence) to our Registrar, Bruce Van Every on 9889 1760 so that some arrangement can be made. ***The most important thing is that we know by 19th February whether or not your child will be playing in the Winter Season.*** **Please note: no calls after 9:00pm of an evening or Sundays.**

Team Selection: Every effort is made to put players in teams that best suit their ability and age. Decisions are made based on coaches' reports and recommendations and observations made by the Age Group Coordinators. Even after careful consideration it sometimes becomes apparent during the first few games of a season that a child has been placed in the wrong team. The Club reserves the right to change a player's team during the grading games. Any change will be discussed with the player and his/her parents.

Singlet Number: This must be the number the player will wear in the coming season. If there is any doubt, please write an explanatory note on the back of the form. It is only by having an accurate list of singlet numbers for each age group that we can, hopefully, avoid clashes when issuing new uniforms and selecting teams. The relevant Age Group Coordinator must be advised immediately of any change of singlet number.

Uniform: New singlet and shorts can be purchased from Penny Hauser – please allow three to four weeks for collection of new uniforms from date of order. To buy a second hand uniform, you may also contact Penny Hauser on 9889 8484. **Please note: no calls after 9:00pm of an evening or Sundays.**

Commitment: Players are required to commit to one, one-hour training session per week (per team unless otherwise agreed) plus the game. Any player, who is unable to attend training, or a match, must let the Coach or Team Manager know as soon as possible. Players will also be required to pay a weekly match fee of approximately \$4.00 to \$5.00, this covers stadium and referee costs. Most stadiums also charge an admission fee of approximately \$2.00 for players and spectators.
